This step by step illustrated Tutorial will show you

- How to install Turbo Tube Engage
- How to use Turbo Tube Engage

It's taken as granted that you have already a hosting account where you will install the software.

Since you're reading the manual for the PRO version it's also taken as granted that you have created your JVZoo, ClickBank or Aweber accounts in order to integrate them with the software.

Lastly, you're supposed to have your video uploaded at YouTube so to use it with the Turbo Tube Engage.

REMEMBER THAT YOU MAY NEED A SPECIAL PERMISSION FOR USING OTHER PEOPLES' VIDEOS WITH THIS SOFTWARE.

1 BUG-FREE Software



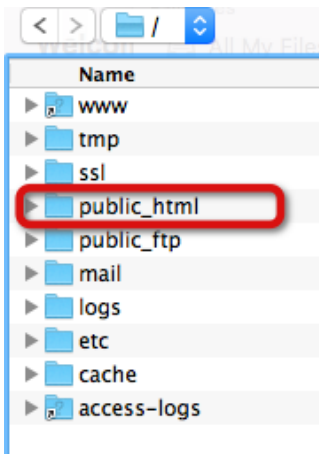
This software has been tested THOROUGHLY so to enjoy a BUG-FREE functionality.

The following issues are KNOWN and there is no technical way to be changed, because the technology does not allow EVERYTHING.:

1. The video resulted by Turbo Tube Engage cannot be viewed by iPhone, because Flash is not supported. Android cell phones will display everything right.
2. The CUSTOM HTML you will add, text and images ARE NOT 100% mobile friendly. There was no way to control that, so be sure NOT to use big fonts and/or big images.
3. The same applies to the SUBSCRIPTION FORMS: they are not 100% mobile friendly. There was no way to control that, so be sure NOT to use a long headline.

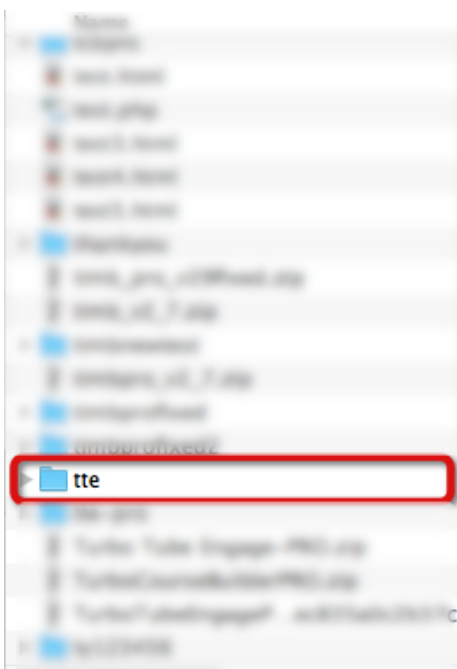
ANY other "issue" you may have it'd be related to the server you use and we are here to support you!

2 Connect to your server



Connect to your server via FTP and open the /public_html directory - in some servers it is the /www directory, or /htdocs. Alternatively you may login to your cPanel and use the File Manager to reach that directory.

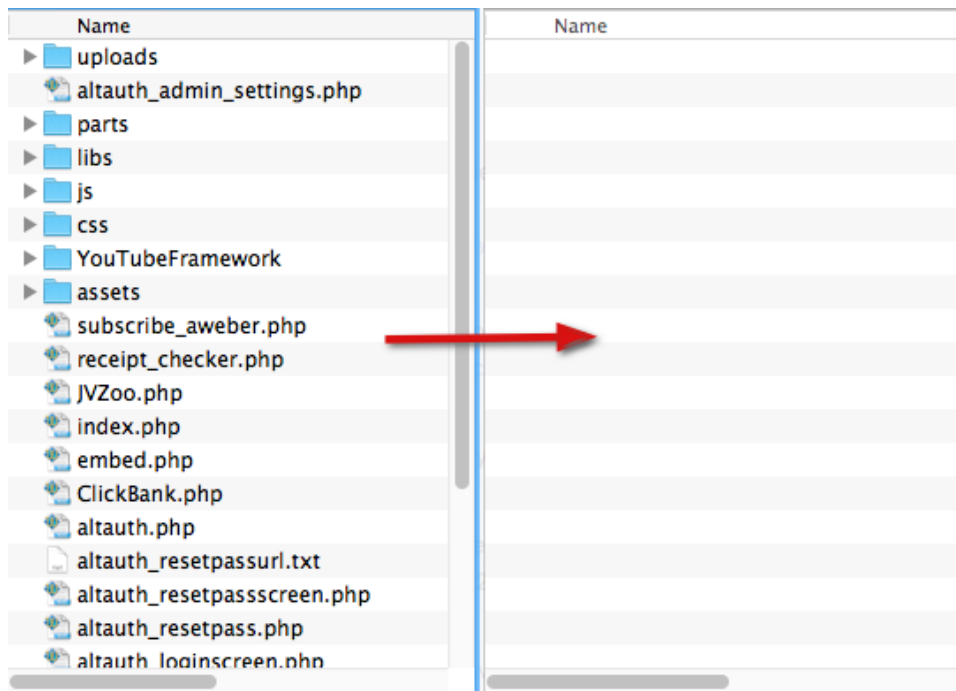
3 Create a directory



Create a directory on your server. That directory will hold the administration area and this will be the directory where you will add the lessons of your course. You can name that directory as you wish - for example 'the'

4 Upload all files



Once you create the directory on your server you just upload all files of the software into that new directory.

5 Reach the directory in your browser

 mydomain.com/tte-pro

Open your browser and type in the URL of the directory you have created. So for example if your domain name was mydomain.com and the directory you used was **tte** then the URL you'd use would be mydomain.com/tte

6 Installation is done

You need to edit alauth_admin_settings.php and reupload the updated file on your server, where you uploaded the files initially. Overwrite the existing file there.

Open alauth_admin_settings.php using a TEXT EDITOR and replace YOUR AWEVER APP ID HERE with the ID of the app you created in Aweber. Again be sure save the changes and re-upload that file in the directory where you initially uploaded Turbo Tube Engage's files.
